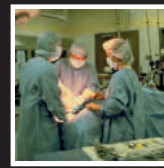
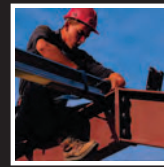

# How the Register is arranged

The *UK Register of Expert Witnesses* is designed to help litigation lawyers locate competent expert witnesses. In combining a book and on-line searching, the *Register* offers lawyers the most flexible expert search tool in the UK market today.

Those experts (over 75%) who have opted to be vetted by us are clearly marked, together with the total number of positive recommendations received and the date of most recent vetting.

## Subject index

The subject index is in many ways the most important part of the *Register*. It is compiled from the fields of expertise detailed in the list of expert witnesses and is comprehensively cross-indexed to ensure that very few terms merely refer you to another term.

## Numbers and regions

The numbers in the index refer to the entries for the experts concerned, not to the pages on which their entries appear. The letter in front of each number identifies the geographical region in which the expert is based. All entries from a region are listed together and sorted into ascending numerical order.

The **regional identifiers** are:

A South West England	H Wales
B Southern England	J West Midlands
C South East England	K East Midlands
D Greater London	L Northern England
E East Anglia	N Southern Scotland
F Thames Valley	P Highlands & Islands
G Severn Valley	R Northern Ireland

By knowing the code letter for your geographical region you can quickly locate experts near to you. For even greater certainty, the boundaries of the regions are shown on the map printed on the flap at the front of the book.

## Additional indexes


If you are not sure in which region or postal area a particular town is located, please refer to the regional map and index on the fold-out flap at the front of the *Register*, or to the town index on page 335. However, if you already know the name of the expert you are seeking, or the name of the firm for which the expert works, the indexes of surnames (page 305) and company names (page 310) will provide a quick means of tracking down the required entry.

Finally, on page 314 we have provided a guide to many of the post-nominal abbreviations that appear in the *Register*. (The Abbreviations Index has been compiled from information provided by the listed expert witnesses. It is not intended to be, nor should it







be used as, an authority as to the meaning of any particular term.)

## Codes and symbols




Codes and symbols are used throughout the list of expert witnesses to represent various categories of information. Within the body of an entry you may see any of the following:

-  Telephone
- F Fax
- E E-mail
- W Website
- Dx Document exchange
- G Geographical limits
- L Languages spoken (in addition to English)

In addition, any combination of the following symbols may appear alongside entries to indicate that the expert:

-  is prepared to discuss a potential instruction by telephone for 10 minutes free of charge
-  has lodged a profile sheet
-  has lodged a CV
-  is prepared to undertake legally aided work
-  is prepared to be instructed in criminal cases
-  is prepared to be instructed as a single joint expert.

Finally, one of the following symbols may appear for medical practitioners who are prepared to be instructed as expert witnesses in cases alleging **medical malpractice**:

-  only on behalf of the medical attendant
-  only on behalf of the patient
-  on behalf of either the medical attendant or the patient.

# Expert vetting procedure

From its beginnings in 1988, the *UK Register of Expert Witnesses* has used an objective method of vetting potential registrants. Our vetting procedure is concerned only with checking the *witness* part of the *expert witness* equation. Still, it has stood the test of time, and was, indeed, adopted by the Law Society of England and Wales when it started publishing a list of its own.

We ensure that all experts listed as 'vetted' are **independently vetted** by us. There are **no exceptions** to our vetting procedure. So users of our services can be certain that **all** expert witnesses listed by the *Register* as 'vetted' have experience of acting as expert witnesses.

## Vetting procedure

On receipt of an expert application requesting vetting:

- We contact instructing solicitors (or barristers or legal executives) asking for an opinion as to their satisfaction with the expert concerned.
- If the legal professional feels able to make a recommendation of the expert to legal colleagues in general, then their assessment of the expert is recorded and the expert marked as 'vetted'.

## Periodic re-vetting

Once experts have been successfully vetted, they have the option to undertake re-vetting.

Re-vetting enables experts to subject themselves to periodic review by instructing lawyers. We ask each lawyer referee whether he or she is able to make a general recommendation as to the expert's abilities as an expert witness in a number of key categories, including:

- SJE work
- criminal work
- civil work
- report writing
- courtroom skills
- cross-examination.

An expert's on-line entry reflects the most current vetting date for each aspect of expert witness work vetted, plus a running total of the number of individuals who have recommended the expert witness. From this, lawyers will be able to gain an appreciation for each expert of:

- how recently the vetting was undertaken
- the total number of recommendations received.

Within the printed *Register* we publish a generalised 'last vetted' date, as well as the total number of positive recommendations gained by the expert.

## Individual listings

The vast majority of entries list individuals rather than companies. This is because it is an individual you will be instructing, and it is the individual in whom you will want to have confidence.

## Quality control

If you have a complaint about any expert witness instructed from the *Register*, please contact us and we will investigate the matter.

## Register logo

The *Register* logo may be used by those experts who have passed our vetting procedure and are listed in the current edition of the *UK Register of Expert Witnesses*. There is no charge made for using our logo. Use of the logo by an expert implies nothing more than they are listed in the current edition.



Vetted experts may also use a dated version of the *Register* logo bearing the year of their most recent recommendation.
